

Get involved in the Recycle Your Cycle scheme

Recycle Your Cycle works with hospice shops to collect unwanted bikes, which are then repaired and refurbished by a prison workshop scheme. The scheme provides hospice shops the perfect opportunity to transform unwanted bikes into vital funds for hospice care.

How to get involved? It's really easy!

1

Contact Recycle your Cycle and let them know you want to get involved. You can then start to encourage your supporters and customers to donate bikes to your shop.

Don't forget to use our handy poster to help promote the scheme!

2

Contact Recycle Your Cycle to arrange a convenient time to pick up your bike donations. Recycle Your Cycle will then do all the hard work for you!

3

Once the bikes are returned to your shop from the workshops they are ready to sell. Bikes are returned with a six month warranty and RYC will even provide a recommended retail price but the final figure is up to you!

What else you might need to know?

What kind of bikes do Recycle Your Cycle take?

Recycle Your Cycle can take all types of bikes including children's, youth and adult bikes.

What if my hospice doesn't get any bikes donated?

Do not worry, Recycle Your Cycle are able to supply fully refurbished bikes to hospice shops to sell.

How the money works!

After you have sold the bike, you will remit a small handling fee to Recycle Your Cycle: £15 per children's bike, £25 per youth bike and £35 per adult bike. The remaining proceeds of the sale go to your hospice.
